#### Matthew 25:35-36

For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me.'



#### Matthew 25:42-43

For I was hungry and you gave me nothing to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me nothing to drink, I was a stranger and you did not invite me in, I needed clothes and you did not clothe me, I was sick and in prison and you did not look after me.' "Brother s and sisters" (ἀδελφό ς)

But you are not to be called 'Rabbi,' for you have one Teacher, and you are all brothers.

Then Jesus said to them, "Do not be afraid. Go and tell my brothers to go to Galilee; there they will see me.
